Are you eligible for a booster dose?

Category	Booster Dose
Completed 2 doses of Sinopharm	 6 months after the second dose
Completed 2 doses of Sinopharm (from high risk category)	 3 months after the second dose
Vaccinated with (Pfizer-Biontech, AstraZeneca, Sputnik V)	

Recovered?

Are you eligible for a **booster dose**?

Category	Booster Dose
Recovered in 2020 and completed 2 doses of Sinopharm	✓
Recovered in 2021 and completed 2 doses of Sinopharm	✗

Are you eligible for a **vaccine**?

	Vaccine
Recovered in 2020 and didn't receive the vaccine yet	Take 2 doses of any vaccine
Recovered in 2021 and didn't receive the vaccine yet	Take one dose of (Pfizer-Biontech) or 2 doses of any other vaccine

FAQ's

Who is eligible for a booster dose after 3 months of taking the second dose of the Sinopharm vaccination?

Individuals who are in a high-risk category, such as:

- Frontliners
- Individuals 50 years of age or above
- Those with chronic diseases or obesity



FAQ's

I Recovered in 2020 and received 2 doses of Sinopharm, am I eligible for a booster dose?

Yes, eligible :
6 months after the second dose
3 months after the second dose
(if in a high risk category)



FAQ's

I Recovered in 2021 and received 2 doses of Sinopharm, am I eligible for a booster dose?

No, you are not eligible



FAQ's

I got infected with COVID-19 after receiving the first dose of the vaccine, do I have to take the second dose?

Yes, you have to receive the second dose according to your vaccination schedule.

- If the date for your second dose coincides with your quarantine, you must take the second dose directly after completing your quarantine.
